Don't worry if you can't make our party, you can always help us plan for the next 30 years by donating to our £30 for 30 Years fundraising campaign.

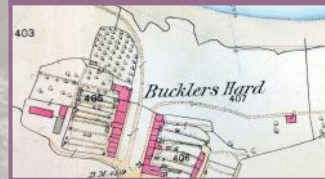
