

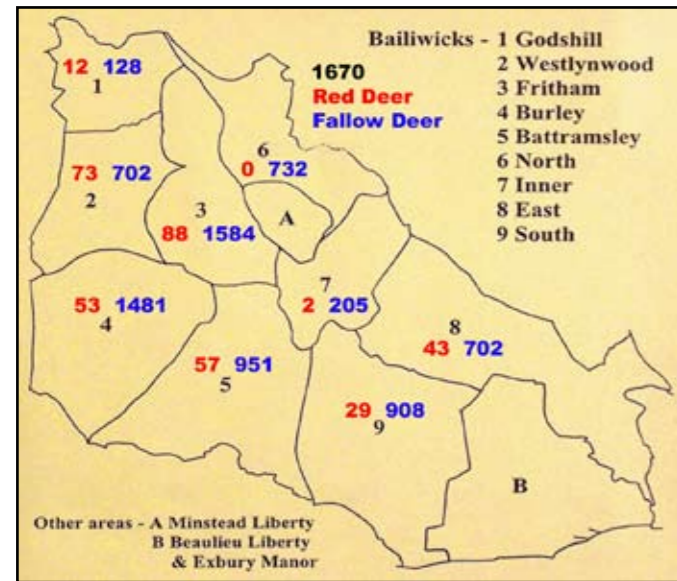

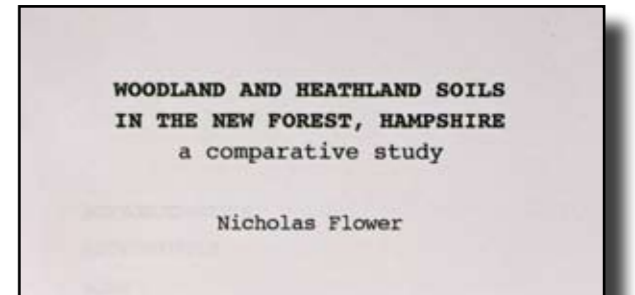
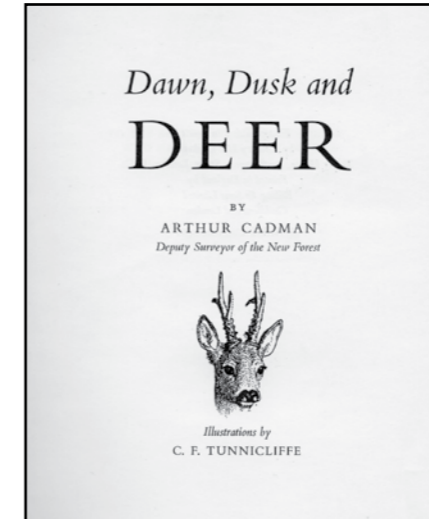
Wild gladioli

Many books have been produced to explain the varied wildlife of the New Forest. The Library also holds a number of unpublished works.

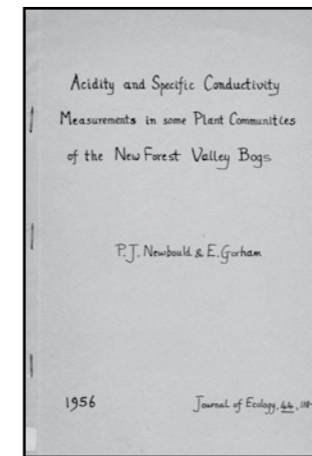
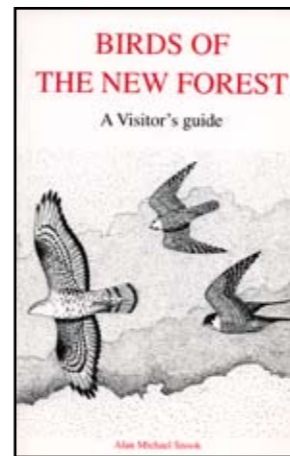
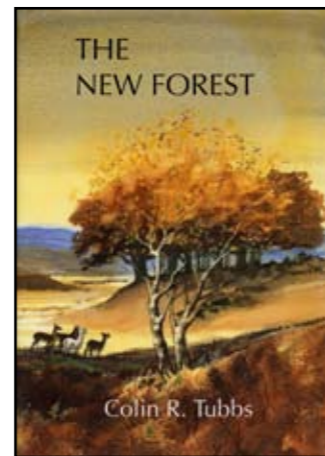
Nicholas Flower

is a keen natural historian who produced a number of illuminating papers on the Forest.

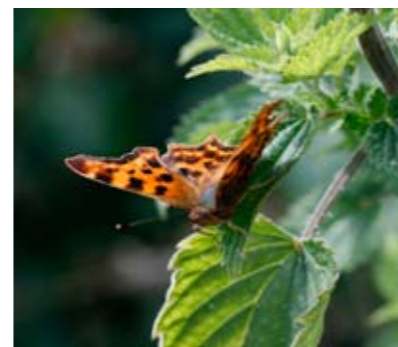
Colin Tubbs' book
