Geology

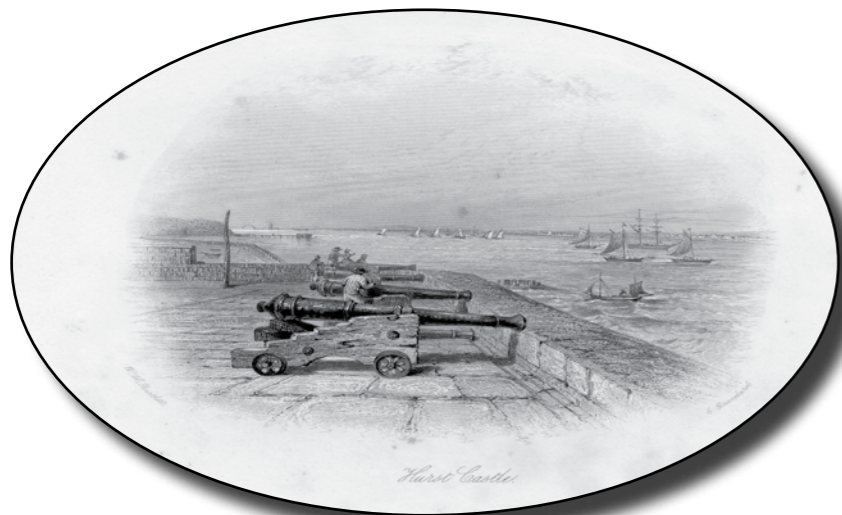
has shaped the land and the way it can be used. The underlying pattern is shown on maps.
